Introduction

At the CAUTHE Executive Meeting, held in Brisbane in February 2004, it was decided that a survey be carried out of all tourism and hospitality program providers in Australia. This was deemed desirable because, as the key Australian organisation representing tourism education provision, it was felt CAUTHE should have a clear picture of student numbers, a grasp of future likely trends affecting the sector and be in a position to make clear and accurate public statements on the nature and health of the industry.

A report was prepared for and presented to the CAUTHE Executive at the Annual General Meeting in Alice Springs in February 2005. The current report provides the updated figures as received from the Department of Education Science and Training (DEST) for 2004. The following tables contrast 2003 and 2004 figures by undergraduate, masters, other postgraduate and PhD by state. Additional tables present undergraduate and masters enrolments by institution as provided by DEST.
