Mieke is a lecturer at the School of Tourism and Hospitality Management at Southern Cross University and brings with her more than 25 years' experience in teaching in transnational tertiary institutions. She has been a long term member of the SCU Teaching and Learning Advisory Committee and the Emerging Technologies Advisory Group. She is the winner of SCU's 2004 Vice Chancellor's Award for Excellence and Achievement and the 2007 Vice Chancellor's Award for Teaching Excellence. She has led teaching teams to significantly reduce attrition in large and diverse first year cohorts using teaching with technologies and intelligent curriculum design.

Dr. Pierre Benckendorff *BAdmin(Tourism)(Hons), PhD (JCU)*

Pierre is an award winning university lecturer specialising in tourism education and training. He has held several teaching and learning leadership positions at The University of Queensland and James Cook University. His experience includes curriculum design, quality assurance and accreditation in business, tourism and hospitality education. In 2007 he received a Carrick (OLT) citation for outstanding contributions to student learning. He has also played an active role in several national projects funded by the Australian Government Office for Learning and Teaching. Pierre will share his experiences of using technology to implement a flipped classroom for a cohort of master students.
