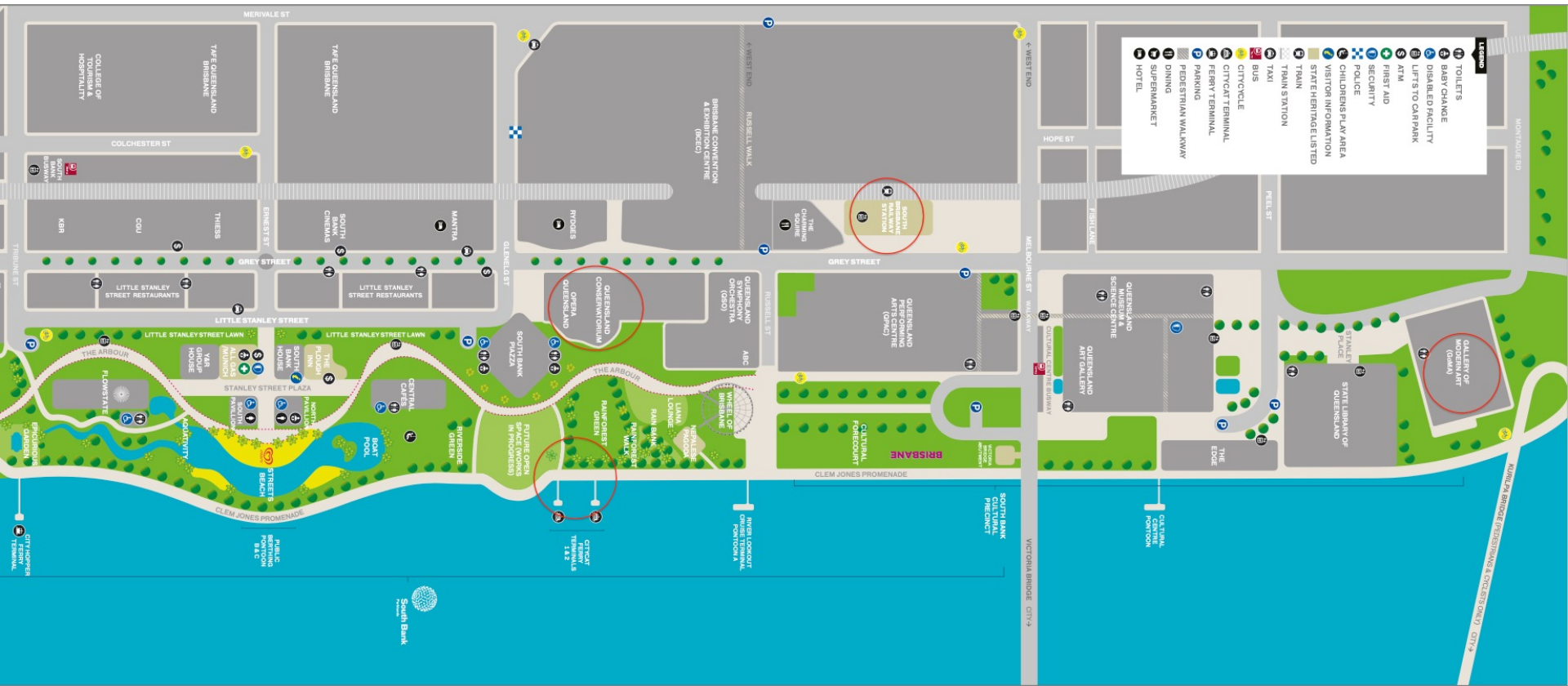

- Accessible from Southbank by new ferry terminal (due for completion in Dec 2021)



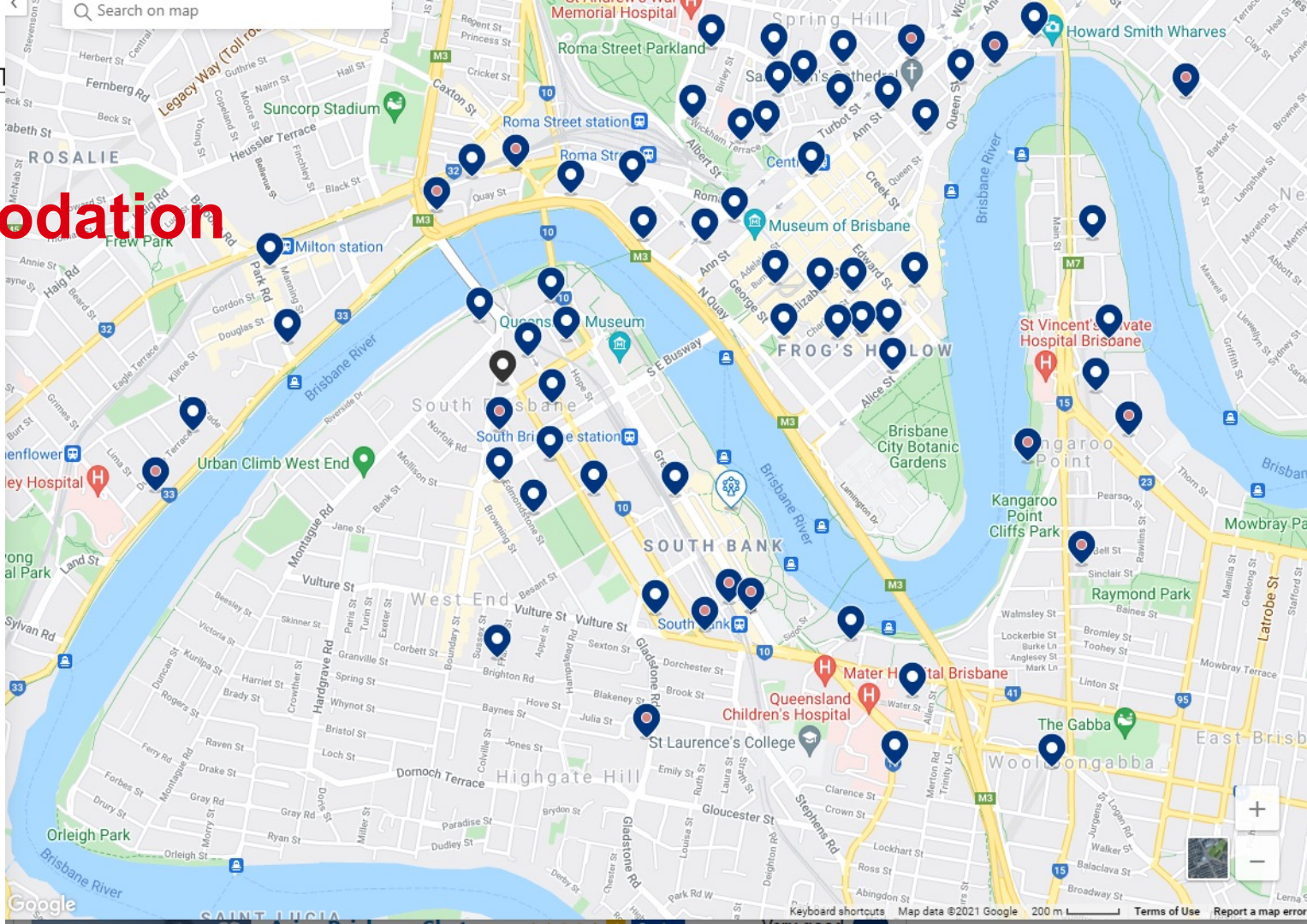
