

Call for Expressions of Interest

Associate Editor, Journal of Hospitality and Tourism Management (JHTM)

The Executive Committee of the Council for Australasian Tourism and Hospitality Education (CAUTHE) is seeking an Associate Editor for its official journal, the Journal of Hospitality and Tourism Management (JHTM), published and distributed by Elsevier. The JHTM has been steadily growing during the last years experiencing a continuous increase in submissions. CAUTHE is calling for expressions of interest from suitably qualified and experienced colleagues. Ideally, the new associate editor will complement the existing team of associate editors in terms of geographical and/or discipline specialization.

The journal has been in existence for over 30 years, is published online and it has been growing from strength to strength, e.g. 7.6 SSCI impact factor in 2023, Q1 and A ranked journal in the ABDC journal quality list, one of the top 10 journals in tourism and hospitality). The CAUTHE Executive continuously invest resources in order to further grow and advance the impact of the journal. The journal attracts submissions from a wider multi-disciplinary and it aims to increase its appeal to a greater international scholar audience. With the increasing number of submissions, maintenance of quality standards is of paramount importance.

The journal is committed to a broad range of topics including tourism and travel management, hospitality management, leisure and recreation studies and event management. It contains both theoretical and applied research papers and encourages the submission of the results of collaborative research undertaken between academia and industry. The journal is keen to promote interdisciplinary papers that are theoretically informed and that can contribute to improving practice.

JHTM Associate Editor selection criteria:

- 1. Vision for the journal
- 2. Approach to achieve the JHTM vision and personal contributions to the JHTM strategy
- 3. Publication record
- 4. Demonstrated experience as an (associate) editor and/or project manager or similar team leadership role
- 5. Institutional hosting and support for the Associate Editor role (e.g. support letter from head of school).

The appointment will be for two years and the successful candidate should be able to start their duties as soon as possible. The Associate Editor will be supported by the Editor in Chief (Professor Marianna Sigala), the other four Associate Editors, an international Editorial Advisory Board and an Editorial Review Board comprising 50+ leading academics.
