Description

Online learning technologies have transformed educational experiences by enabling more flexible and structured learning approaches. These digital platforms offer benefits such as personalised learning pathways, ability to track student achievements, opportunities to intervene and support student progress, and activation of previously passive learning contexts. While online learning technologies provide powerful educational tools, they risk fragmenting the learning experience if not carefully integrated with traditional classroom instruction. **Outcomes from the workshop** will include principles for designing active, collaborative, and engaging learning and a design for activating and collaborative learning within a unit/subject, and a framework for topic learning.
